As we begin this new year, we certainly hope that the new members of the Ohio General Assembly will finally have the courage to step up to the plate and handle the

legislative request placed before them by Ohio PERS.

Ohio PERS and its members and retirees have acted responsibly in seeking and distributing pensions and benefits to its retirees. PERI has always taken into account what was best for the long-range funding of the retirement system, before it asked for any improvements to its members' retirement package. The OPERS board has always been proactive in seeking appropriate and measured legislative rule changes so it could maintain the health of the fund. Now it is time for our legislators to act in a responsible and timely manner.

Since January of 2010, there has been an onslaught of negative press about public pensions. These articles have lumped together pension situations from multiple states, set up in multiple formats, and funded in multiple ways. The newspaper

Legislative Email-Alert Program

For the past two years PERI has been developing its legislative alert email capabilities. We quickly learned that we had to become our own internet service provider (ISP) in order to have the ability to send more than 300 emails at a time. We have also learned that those wanting to receive the alerts had to list us as an approved sender with their personal ISP. (AOL, Yahoo, Gmail, Hotmail etc.)

In late December, we sent out two information pieces to our 5,500 legislative alert members; a little over 500 bounced back to us for a variety of reasons. The biggest reason was: we had not been listed as an approved sender. The next biggest was that the email address we have on file was no longer current.

This legislative informational tool has been very much appreciated by those who participate. Mainly because we guard our email list and do not share it with anyone. Then there is the fact that we only send emails when the information is critical to understand what is going on in the legislature, or in the legislative environment as it pertains to our pension system. If I recall correctly, there were only 4 emails in all of 2010.

Legislative Report

With the new year, we began a new session of the Ohio General Assembly—the 129th which will run until December 31, 2012. The Ohio General Assembly operates on a two-

year cycle. The 128th General Assembly adjourned in late December. All bills that were left pending are dead and must be re-introduced in this new General Assembly.

During this term the Governor's office, as well as the majority membership in the Ohio House of Representatives and Ohio Senate, are held by members of the Republican Party.

According to the Columbus Dispatch, other newspapers, and political pundits, the 128th General Assembly set a modern record for inactivity. Both Houses met less often and passed fewer bills than most past General Assemblies. The Columbus Dispatch reported (12/26/10) that "during the previous 20 years...an average of 247 bills became law in each two-year legislative session. This session: 58....Since 1997, the House and Senate each met about 83 times in every session. This session, the Senate met 58 times and the House 52—barely once every two weeks."

My commitment to you, as well as that of our board and staff, is to stay alert and to make sure that all of our members are informed; so that you will have the tools to communicate accurately with your individual legislators.

John E. Haught Elected District 11 Representative

Due to the election of its District Representative, Jack Murphy, to the position of PERI's 3rd Vice-Chair, a special chapter by chapter election to replace him, was held in District 11 during the months of November and December.



Mr. Haught, holds a Bachelor's Degree in Education, a Master's Degree in Educational Administration, and has completed post graduate course work, toward a Doctoral degree in Educational Administration and Organizational Management.

Mr. John E. Haught, the current legislative officer for PERI Chapter 28, Lake County was elected and was installed at the PERI Board meeting in January. writers have then denigrated our pension systems in Ohio, utilizing these flawed premises.

Even within the boundaries of Ohio, each of the retirement systems must be examined on its own merits. Some are in trouble, because they have promised more pension and benefits than their funding could generate. Others are in trouble because they distributed too many dollars when times were good.

But! Ohio PERS and its members and retirees have acted responsibly. Our petitions before the Ohio General Assembly need to be considered on our merits, not on those of other systems in Ohio, and definitely not pension woes in other states. To this end, PERI has been preparing our chapter members to communicate with their local legislators. The best tool to insure good legislation is accurate information, communicated to local representatives by their constituents.

I would suggest that all of you who can, join your local chapter. If that is not available, join the Legislative Email-Alert Network [Explained on page one]. Most importantly, write or call your legislator's office when asked to do so. Your personal input goes a long way in securing good legislation. ❄️

Although the past General Assembly enacted fewer bills than most past General Assemblies, it may have been a blessing in disguise because PERI opposed a number of the bills that would have affected OPERS and that were left pending. What follows is a review of some of the issues and bills that PERI followed during the 128th General Assembly:

PENSION PLAN DESIGN CHANGES: Responding to the Ohio Retirement Study Council's request, in the fall of 2009, each of the five retirement systems formally recommended to the legislature proposals designed to strengthen their respective pension systems and to maintain adequate funding for health care. It should be noted that each system submitted its own plan and that the plans submitted by each of the systems were different.

Of the various provisions submitted by OPERS, one will affect future retirees; this provision deals with the COLA. The 3% rate would remain except in those years when the consumer price index is less than 3%. Thus, if the CPI is 3% or more, the retiree would receive a 3% COLA. However, should the CPI be less, the retiree would receive the same percentage rate as the CPI. For example, if the CPI were 2%, the retiree would receive a 2% COLA. And unlike years past, retirees will not be able to "bank" points when the CPI exceeds 3% and then use them when the CPI is below 3%. Since no legislation, to this effect, was introduced in the 128th General Assembly, we anticipate that it will be during this session.

PUBLIC RECORDS: During this past year there was a great deal of media attention given to the possibility of legislation being introduced that would open up state retirement systems' member records to public view. This was in response to requests for these records made by the eight largest newspapers in the state. These newspapers stated that they wanted access to these records to analyze data for possible abuses in the pension system.

After careful consideration and review of current law, and after consultation with the Ohio Attorney General, the five systems declined to release the requested information. Attorneys for OPERS and the Attorney General correctly interpreted current Ohio law and concluded that much of the information requested is not a public record and thus not subject to public disclosure. In short, by law the retirement systems are not allowed to release certain information; as a consequence, there were legislators who announced that they would introduce legislation to change the law and make these records public. No such legislation surfaced; however, this issue could surface again this year.

BUDGET ISSUE: In mid-June of 2009, Governor Strickland outlined a budget framework in an effort to plug a \$3.2 billion gap in the state's fiscal years 2010-2011 operating budget. One provision of the plan called for a reduction in state employer retirement contributions from 14% to 8% of salary. This would have had a major impact on health care benefits because health care benefits are funded from employer contributions. Reducing the employer contribution rate to 8% would eliminate the portion of the contribution that goes to fund health care, and it would also have required OPERS to draw down the current health care fund to stay within the 30-year funding requirement. PERI, and other stakeholders, held a joint press conference at the Statehouse, attended hearings, and educated their representative about our objections to this proposal. The budget bill passed and fortunately this provision was not in the bill and therefore was not enacted.

S. B. No. 219 (Sen. Grendell) The bill was introduced in response to an ongoing public corruption criminal investigation in Cuyahoga County and addresses a disability issue related to the investigation. Apparently an individual plead guilty to public corruption in federal court and then filed for disability benefits. The disability apparently relates to the anxiety of being caught and prosecuted for the public cor-

ruption. Although the bill would not affect this individual, it attempted to prevent this from happening again.

We testified in support of the bill in both the Senate and House. The bill was recommended by the Ohio Retirement Study Commission; it passed the Senate and was reported out of committee in the House. However, it never reached the House floor for a vote and thus did not pass.

H. B. No. 177 (Rep. Huffman) provided that those engaged in securities transactions or making investments on behalf of STRS may not receive performance-based bonuses or premiums in years of negative investment returns. Instead the individual would only be entitled to compensation for services the individual rendered, and any term or condition of a contract agreement between STRS and investment personnel which provides a performance-based bonus or premium would be void.

It should be noted that the bill as introduced did not affect OPERS; however, it could have been amended to include OPERS and the other systems because OPERS internally manages about 60% of its investment assets and does provide a performance-based bonus.

It should be noted that the Ohio Retirement Study Council voted to recommend that the Legislature disapprove the bill, and PERI and OPERS also formally opposed the bill. The bill did not pass.

H. B. No. 30 (Rep. Combs) dealt with retirement incentive plans. It would have required an analysis of each proposed retirement incentive plan for OPERS members and would have prohibited a member who participates in such a retirement incentive plan from being re-employed by the same employer.

More specifically, the employer would be required to have the incentive plan analyzed by a state university located within a specified geographic area of the employer.

The analysis was to include a cost-benefit analysis of the plan that compares the projected long-term savings of the plan with the projected cost to the employer of purchasing the credit for participants along with a recommendation on the advisability of establishing the plan. The employer would not be required to follow the recommendation.

Under the bill any employee who participates in a retirement incentive plan could not be re-employed after retirement by the same employer employing unit for which the retirement incentive plan was established. That is, a retired OPERS member who participates in a retirement incentive plan may still be re-employed, but would be prohibited from being re-employed by the employer that established the retirement incentive plan under which the employee retired.

PERI monitored the bill; it did not pass.

S. B. No. 20 (Sen. Carey) would have amended Sections 9.44 and 124.181 to permit state employees to receive longevity and vacation credit for prior military service.

Current law allows for the purchase of service credit for military service time and the bill would have allowed their purchased service time to count toward longevity and vacation credits. The proposed amend-

ment to Section 9.44 provided that a person employed by the state (other than an elective official) who is currently earning vacation credits, would be entitled to have prior service as a member of the armed services or a reserve component counted as service with the state for the purpose of computing the amount of vacation leave.

The proposed amendment to Section 124.181 provided that a state employee may have prior service as a member of the armed forces or a reserve component counted as service with the state for the purpose of determining the amount of the longevity salary adjustment. As you may recall, longevity pay adjustments generally begin to accrue after an employee has attained five years of service.

PERI monitored bill; it did not pass.

S. B. No. 83 (Sen. Faber) One provision of the bill attempted to address the concern we have with spiking—the practice that allows employees to earn a higher pension benefit by virtue of unusually higher pay in the final years of their career—this creates an unfunded liability for the system. We oppose spiking and anticipate that this spiking issue, in whole or in part, may be addressed in the Pension Plan Design proposal discussed above.

Another provision in the bill excluded from earnable salary any amounts that

exceed the yearly compensation of the Governor. For these amounts, neither the member nor the employer would be required to make contributions to OPERS.

Amounts earned in excess of the Governor's salary would therefore not be used in determining a retirement benefit under OPERS. The Governor's salary is approximately \$145,000. A federal law provision set the limit at \$245,000. (Thus, under federal law, no contributions are collected on the salary amount that exceeds \$245,000.) OPERS indicates that lowering this threshold to approximately \$145,000 could have a negative effect on the Health Care Fund.

As you know, a retirement benefit is based on a formula using years of service and final average salary. Final average salary is the average of the member's highest three years of earnable salary. Earnable salary is the salary, wages, and other earnings of a member, other than payments for such things as fringe benefits and reimbursement of expenses. A member and the member's employer are required to make contributions based on the member's earnable salary.

PERI basically supports the concepts of the bill, but has concerns with the way the bill attempted to address the issue. The bill did not pass. ❄️

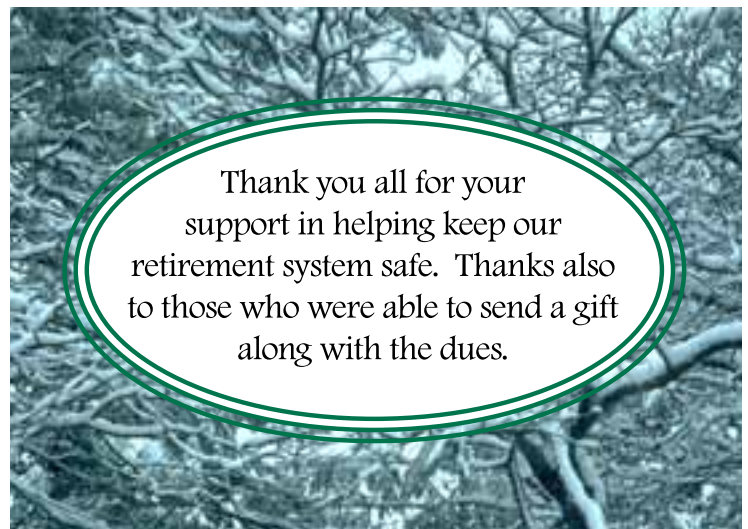

OPERS Medicare Part D Prescription Plan – Q & A

Now that Medicare-eligible OPERS retirees are beginning to utilize the new OPERS Medicare Part D Plan, we would like to share the answers to some questions we've received. Our goal is to ease the transition to the new plan. Questions or concerns should be directed to Express Scripts at 1-800-789-7416.

Q: What will my co-pays be under the OPERS Medicare D Plan?

A: Your 2011 co-pays will remain the same as in 2010.

Q: My local pharmacy is having trouble filling my medication. Can you help?

A: Your local pharmacist can call the Express Scripts Pharmacy Help Desk at 1-800-824-0898.

Q: Do I have a coverage gap (donut hole)?

A: No. The OPERS Medicare Part D Prescriptions Plan does not have a coverage gap (donut hole).

Q: My new ID card has been lost (or damaged). How do I get a new ID card?

A: Call Express Scripts Customer Service at 1-800-789-7416 and they will send you a new card right away.

Q: What if I don't have my new ID card when I go to the pharmacy?

A: If you don't have your new OPERS Medicare D Plan ID card with you when you fill your prescription, ask the pharmacy to call Express Scripts to get the necessary information.

If the pharmacy is not able to get the necessary information, you may have to pay the full cost of the prescription when you pick it up. You can then ask Express Scripts to reimburse you for their share of the cost.

Q: I forgot about my new ID card and had to pay the full cost for my prescription at the pharmacy. How do I get reimbursed?

A: Complete a claim form, which can be requested through Express Scripts customer service.

Q: I went to the pharmacy and was told that my prescription coverage was expired? What should I do?

A: First, please be sure that you are using your new ID card. The prescription coverage indicated by your old Express Scripts card has expired and will not be honored. If you did not receive a new ID card for the OPERS Medicare Part D Plan or have additional questions, please contact Express Scripts. Your group number for the OPERS Medicare Part D plan is JYR.

WHAT PUBLIC PENSIONS DO FOR ALL OHIOIANS

Because of the year long newspaper attacks on the Ohio pension setup, Ohio PERS developed the following as part of a three tiered approach to explain how retirement security benefits everyone in Ohio. We are only including the text here. The supporting documentation for the statistics can be found in the OPERS handout entitled "Ohio PERS Message Triangle."

PERI believes these points need to be explained by each retiree to their local Senator and Representative.

PENSIONS SUPPORT OUR LOCAL ECONOMY

1. THE BUCK STAYS HERE

1. The pension is what neighbors and friends live on and spend here.
2. Most retirees and their dependents remain in the state; reinvesting their retirement dollars on housing, goods, and services.
 - In 2006, state and local pension funds in Ohio and other states paid a total of \$8.41 billion in benefits to Ohio residents. Retirees' expenditures from these benefits supported a total of \$11.2 billion in total economic output in the state, and \$4.7 billion in value added in the state.
 - \$8.0 billion in direct economic impacts were supported by retirees' expenditures on goods and services from businesses in the state. An additional \$1.6 billion in indirect economic impact resulted when these businesses purchased additional goods and services, generating additional income in the local economy.
 - \$1.6 billion in induced impacts occurred when employees hired by businesses as a result of the direct and indirect impacts made expenditures, supporting even more additional income.

2. RETIREES VOLUNTEER HERE

1. They support our communities by volunteering, mentoring and by donating their time in this state.

- Each year, older Ohioans spend more than 350,000 hours of their time helping people of all ages (“Ohio Department of Aging Volunteer Opportunities,” April 2010).
- Participants in the Volunteer Ombudsman Associate Program regularly volunteer in nursing homes and other long-term care facilities.
- Ohio Senior Health Insurance Information Program Volunteers provide information and health insurance services to Ohioans covered by Medicare.
- More than 16,000 retired Ohioans age 55 and older volunteer for a number of non-profit organizations benefiting children, the elderly and community improvement.
- Through the Foster Grandparent Program, volunteers age 60 and over tutor, mentor

and provide emotional support to children, young people and single mothers.

- The Senior Companion Program offers volunteers age 60 and over the opportunity to provide companionship to frail older adults in their community who need extra assistance to live independently.
- Other volunteer opportunities for older Ohioans include the Ohio Citizen Corps (offering neighborhood watch programs, community emergency response teams, and terrorism awareness and prevention), the Ohio Community Service Council (AmeriCorps, service learning, and youth leadership development), and On the Ohio Homefront (connecting families of deployed military personnel with local volunteer services)

3. DEFINED BENEFIT (DB) PLANS HELP RETIREES MAKE IT.

1. Defined benefit plans provide retirees with a lifetime income stream, so they are less likely to require public assistance and social services.
- A defined benefit system is the only system that can ensure that people remain off of welfare. If a generational cohort retires under a defined contribution system with inadequate income, then society is going to have to subsidize these retirees. This “insurance” turns defined contribution plans into a particularly expensive form of defined benefit plan.

4. PUBLIC PENSION BENEFITS LEAVE A SIZEABLE ECONOMIC FOOTPRINT, SUPPORT AND SUSTAIN JOBS AND TAX BASES.

- Defined benefit plan assets promote national saving, economic efficiency, and economic growth. Their size, diversification, and focus on long-term investment returns help them stabilize and add liquidity to American and foreign financial markets alike.
- As shareholders, defined benefit plans promote better corporate performance, reducing the cost of providing plan benefits. For example, defined benefit plans fund the real estate sector, and other less liquid, hard-to-value assets that generally are not invested in by defined contribution.
- In the last decade, many public retirement systems have established target allocations to venture capital projects within

their own state. This innovative, efficient way to finance emerging companies goes a long way in supporting a state's long-term economic growth.

5. PUBLIC PENSIONS ARE A GOOD RETURN.

1. Pensions return over 2 times the amount of contributions from members and employers back into the local economy.
 - Taxpayer Contribution Factor: Each \$1 in taxpayer contributions to Ohio's state and local pension plans supports \$5.73 in total output in the state.
 - Pension Benefit Multiplier: Each \$1 in state and local pension benefits paid to Ohio residents ultimately supports \$1.33 in total output in the state. This "multiplier" incorporates direct and indirect impacts of retiree spending throughout the state's economy.

6. PUBLIC PROVIDE MAIN STREET BENEFITS

1. The average annual pension is \$20,522 - received and spent on Main Street
 - This modest benefit provides those who served the public during their working careers with income to meet basic needs in retirement.

7. BENEFIT IS VITAL TO NON-SOCIAL SECURITY PARTICIPANTS- THIS MAY BE THEIR ONLY RETIREMENT
