INSIGHT FROM THE ADMINISTRATOR

It is about time for the Governor of Ohio, the Speaker of the Ohio House of Representatives, and the President of the Ohio Senate to speak up and promote the economical way Ohio's outstanding public pension systems have generated better than average pensions and benefits for Ohio's retired government employees and the Ohio economy in general.

In the early 1930s and by the way, prior to the establishment of Social Security, the Ohio General Assembly established Ohio's public pension systems for its workers.

Since that time, Ohio's Public Employees Retirement System has grown to the point where it is one of the finest in the country, and recognized nationally for its progressive management and its ability to make measured and balanced changes to keep the system viable.

Throughout the years, Ohio taxpayers have had to pay less for their employees and yet were able to secure better educated, trained, and reliable men and women, because of the state's outstanding retirement package.

For every 30 cents of taxpayer contribution, the retirement system has generated 1 dollar in pension and benefits. What a deal for Ohio's taxpayers and the Ohio economy, not to mention the quality

Legislative Report

The Ohio General Assembly is back in session, but as of this writing there has been little activity on any pension related bills. However, we continue to push for action on the two main retirement bills that have sat idle for the past thirteen months. These are H. B. No. 69 and S. B. No. 3. These bills would implement the recommendations that each of the five retirement systems have proposed in an attempt to fiscally strengthen their respective systems and to maintain adequate funding for health care. PERI supports the recommendations made by OPERS.

Without legislative action, more moneys continue to come out of the Health Care Fund than goes in; and in the near future, the fund will be depleted. Yet, we are told that legislative action may not be undertaken until after the November election. When the legislature resumes hearings on these bills, we anticipate that two issues that we strongly oppose may also be revisited. One provision would lower the employer contribution rate to 12% and raise the employee contribution rate to 12%. The other provision would convert the current defined benefit plans to defined contribution plans. In previous newsletters we have discussed the negative effects these changes would have on the retirement systems.

As for H. B. No. 69 and S. B. No 3, you may recall that they contain the four major recommendations that were proposed by OPERS. One recommendation would add two years to the current age and service eligibility requirement; another changes the final average salary calculation from the three highest calendar years of earnings to the five highest years of earnings. A third recommendation makes a change to the benefit formula. The current 2.2 percent times the final average salary is maintained, but the proposed change extends

retirement package for its workers.

So why aren't our leaders bragging about Ohio's fabulous legislative accomplishment? Could it be because of fear brought on by jealousy, and ignorance of the facts?

For the past five years the newspapers in Ohio have been beating up on public pensions and public employees. Why would they do that? Could it be that in poor economic times people looked around and saw that public employee retirement packages were better than the average? Wasn't that the goal when the pension systems were set up? Why don't our leaders speak up and educate the public? Don't they know that was the original intent of establishing Ohio's own retirement systems: so Ohio could provide its workers with a better retirement, so that Ohio's retirees would be able to continue contributing to the Ohio economy, as opposed to becoming a burden on it!

When times were good and money was flowing, PERI members had to confront some legislators when they attempted to raid the pension funds to promote their political agendas, or to control where the money was invested, or to set aside huge amounts that they could control to fund venture capitalism. Everyone wanted a piece of the pie, because there appeared to be huge amounts of surplus money in the pension funds.

Now we are in a period of economic downturn and the pension funds are not showing huge surpluses. Now we are confronted with some legislators who want to abandonment and destroy the pension system, or convert the defined benefit system into personal investment products.

Who would benefit from that? Maybe it would be stock brokers and personal bankers who, coincidentally, are sometimes big time political campaign contributors. It certainly would not be the Ohio taxpayers, or the Ohio economy, or the individual retiree.

Ohio's political leaders need to be awakened. We need to educate them on the purpose and successes of Ohio's pension systems. We need to encourage them to recognize the wisdom of their predecessors and to once again be proud of Ohio's workers.

How do we, or more specifically you, do this? Write, call, or email your legislator, the Governor, the Speaker, and the Senate President. Urge them to read this article. They all receive the PERI Newsletter at their office.

When you write or call, these are some of the points you want to make:

1. Please recognize the wisdom of establishing Ohio's pension systems, and their value to the taxpayers, the economy, and me personally.
2. I need you to protect my ability to have a dignified and peaceful retirement without the constant fear that some political agenda will destroy it and rob me of my health care coverage.
3. There is, and has been since 2009, legislation proposed (HB69) that adjusts for today's lifetime expectancy and other factors.

Those guiding this legislation have been procrastinating, and they need to quit it. Each day they delay removes principal from the health care fund.

The loss of our health care benefit, in whole or part, is anticipated to raise the cost of my health care coverage between \$6,000 and \$10,000 per year. That is a high cost for me to pay for the personal agenda of a few well-positioned legislators.

4. If the Ohio Retirement Study Council wants to do redundant reports, that's fine, but don't destroy a pension system and its retirement benefits by delaying action today on legislation needed immediately to protect taxpayers, the Ohio economy, and my retirement.

The arrival of a new year brings a few changes to the OPERS health care plan and also a chance for participants to take advantage of programs aimed at improving their health.

New Brand Name Deductible for OPERS Medicare D Plan participants – As of Jan. 1, 2012, formulary and non-formulary **brand name** prescription medications (retail and mail) will be subject to an annual \$50 deductible. Participants in the OPERS Medicare Part D Plan will now pay the first \$50 associated with brand name prescription costs. After the deductible is met, a co-insurance applies.

Becoming Medicare-eligible in 2012? – When an OPERS health care plan participant (retiree or spouse) turns age 65, they become eligible for Medicare coverage. OPERS requires that all eligible participants enroll in Medicare Part A (hospitalization), if eligible without a premium, and Medicare Part B (medical). If you (or your spouse) are turning 65 in the next few months and have not already received information from Social Security about Medicare status, please contact Social Security to apply. Remember, Medicare eligible retirees and their covered spouses must enroll in Medicare B when first eligible. Failure to enroll or pay Medicare B premiums will cost you more out of pocket.

In 2012, OPERS began basing coverage on individual Medicare status, instead of a family status. It is now possible for members of the same family to be covered by different medical plan administrators. The following will help explain how your coverage may change when a participant attains Medicare eligibility.

A single retiree with no dependents enrolled - will be placed in the Humana Medicare Advantage Plan.

A family with all enrolled members having attained Medicare-eligibility - all family members will all be placed in the Humana Medicare Advantage Plan.

A family with both Medicare-eligible and non-Medicare members - Medicare-eligible members will be placed in the Humana Medicare Advantage Plan. Non-Medicare family members will be enrolled in the Medical Mutual Enhanced Plan. Exception: If the family is enrolled in the Medical Mutual Intermediate or Basic Plan the year a family member turns age 65, the family can choose to remain enrolled in their existing plan level. The family member turning 65 must still enroll in Medicare and provide proof of enrollment to OPERS.

Start the new year off Well – OPERS has expanded our health care focus to prevention by offering wellness incentive programs. The idea behind our wellness programs is simple -- provide you with assistance in preventing diseases or improving your current health status.

The objective of these programs is to find a solution that improves your health while reducing OPERS health costs or risks. Studies have repeatedly linked obesity, sedentary lifestyle, tobacco use and poor nutrition to a higher likelihood of developing serious diseases later in life.

Participation in a wellness or disease management program can earn you and your covered spouse incentive dollars in a Retiree Medical Account (RMA). An RMA is a savings account where funds are accumulated exclusively to pay for health care expenses not covered by your health care plan or other health care premiums.

If you aren't already participating in a wellness program, get started by taking a Health Assessment through your medical plan administrator.

the time frame in which the multiplier increases to 2.5 percent. Under the proposal, one must have 35 years of service before the 2.5% kicks in. The fourth major recommendation is one that will affect all future retirees (but not current retirees). This provision deals with the COLA (Cost of Living Allowance). The COLA would be tied to the Consumer Price Index, but it would not exceed 3%. Thus, if the CPI is 3% or more, the retiree would receive a 3% COLA. However, should the CPI be less, the retiree would receive the same percentage rate as the CPI. For example, if the CPI were 2%, the retiree would receive a 2% COLA. And unlike years past, retirees will not be able to "bank" points when the CPI exceeds 3% and then use them when the CPI is below 3%.

It should be noted that the proposal provides for a transition period wherein those

who retire within the first five years after the effective date of the legislation would receive the flat 3% COLA. After five years, their COLA would be tied to the Consumer Price Index.

Another issue that will probably be addressed when hearings resume on the two pension bills is the issue of double-dipping. Although double-dipping has a negligible, if any, financial impact on the system, there has been a great deal of negative press on this issue of late and the public has a negative perception of those who double-dip. Two bills dealing with double-dipping have been introduced. If passed, H. B. No. 388 would suspend, during the period of employment, the retirement benefit of a retiree who returns to public employment. The benefit would be placed in an account maintained by the system for the retiree. The other bill, H. B. No. 202, would limit the retirement benefits for re-employed retirees. Under the limitation provision, a retiree earning in excess of \$14,160 will

forfeit one dollar of retirement benefits for each two dollars of earnable salary. It would also eliminate the DROP program in OP&F. When an individual enters the DROP program, his retirement benefits are calculated but the individual continues to work. While continuing to work, the individual will draw his normal salary and the amount the individual would have received in retirement benefits, plus an annual COLA allowance as well as a portion of the individual's employee contribution and interest, accumulates tax-deferred at OP&F. When the individual ends active employment and retires, it terminates the DROP participation and the individual begins to receive his monthly pension that was determined when he entered the DROP program. At the same time, the individual can begin to withdraw funds from the DROP program in a lump-sum payment or in installments.

OPERS has the PLOP program which is not

affected by the bill. Under this program, an individual can opt to take a lump sum payment as part of his retirement package. Taking such an option would in turn reduce the retiree's monthly benefit by a proportional amount.

Other bills that PERI is monitoring include the following:

H. B. No. 323 would add extortion and perjury to the type of felonies that would result in the forfeiture of retirement benefits and the termination of disability benefits. This proposal was apparently proposed in response to the ongoing public corruption criminal investigation in Cuyahoga County. The proposal would also clarify that the forfeiture provisions also apply to retirants contributing to a public retirement system due to re-employment by a public employer.

Back in 2008, the legislature enacted a law which currently provides that individuals holding an office of honor, trust, or profit who are sentenced for certain felony offenses committed while serving in that position will forfeit the portion of any state retirement benefit that is based on employer contribution. The felonies include bribery, obstructing justice, and theft in office. More specifically, at the time of sentencing, the court in addition to any other penalty it may impose, generally must order the forfeiture of the retirement or disability benefit other than payment of the person's accumulated contributions. Those who serve in a position of honor, trust, or profit include elected officials, certain individuals serving on boards or commissions, key state and local policy-making officials, prosecutors, peace officers, and highway patrol troopers.

Last year, the Ohio General Assembly amended this law in response to the ongoing public corruption criminal investigation in Cuyahoga County, addressing a disability issue related to the investigation. Apparently an individual pled guilty to public corruption in federal court and then filed for disability benefits. The disability apparently relates to the anxiety of being caught

and prosecuted for the public corruption. We testified in support of the proposal and stated that PERI is supportive because we believe that an individual who commits one of the enumerated felony offenses while serving in a position of honor, trust, or profit should not be allowed to receive a disability benefit if the disabling condition arose out of the commission of the offense. For example, the disability is the result of the anxiety and depression from being caught and prosecuted for the crime. Under this law change, the offenses must have been committed after the effective date of the act and the offender was granted a disability benefit prior to disposition of the criminal action. Under this act, the court, prior to sentencing the individual, is to hold a hearing to determine whether the offender's disabling condition arose from the commission of the offense. If the court determines that it was, the court is to order the retirement system to terminate the disability benefit and the system is authorized to recover any disability benefit paid prior to the termination. The act also expanded the definition of "position of honor, trust, or profit" to include positions in which, in the course of public employment, an employee has control over the expenditure of public funds of one hundred thousand dollars or more annually.

Again, H. B. No. 323, if passed, would add extortion and perjury to the type of felonies that would result in the forfeiture of retirement benefits and the termination of disability benefits.

H. B. No. 314 would limit the amount by which a state employee's salary or wage may be increased. Salary increases would be tied to the Consumer Price Index; however, regardless of the CPI, the salary increase cannot exceed 5% even if the CPI is more than 5%. If the CPI decreases or otherwise does not increase during the year, there can be no wage increase. These restrictions do not apply to an employee who is promoted or transferred to a different position. Nor does it apply if the salary has not increased for a significant period of time due to the financial condition of the state and the increase is to compensate for the period of time during which the state faced financial hardship. The proposal does not limit an

employee's progression through the step increases; however, any increase in pay resulting from an employee's progress through the schedules is subject to the limitation of the bill. If passed, this provision will prevail over any conflicting provision of a collective bargaining agreement.

S. B. No. 214 would modify the time frame in which a retirement system, alternative retirement plan, or deferred compensation program must comply with a withholding order for restitution issued on conviction of a public employee for certain sex offenses or theft in office committed in the course of public employment. Currently the withholding occurs when payment is made; the bill makes the withholding current and the amount withheld cancels an equivalent amount of service credit.
