INSIGHT FROM THE ADMINISTRATOR

Since the new OPERS health care plan was announced, I have heard from numerous members wanting to

know where PERI stands on the changes. Our answer is exactly the same as yours, we are against them.

The next question is always: What is PERI going to do about it? To which I reply, what would you like us to do?

Here is the situation: OPERS does not have the money to continue providing the same level of health care that they have in the past. So our choices are picketing at the retirement system, or suing, or how about something ludicrous like setting ourselves on fire in the retirement system lobby? Though these

would be additional actions on behalf of our members, none of them would add one dollar to the health care fund, and if they don't have the money, then they don't have the money.

A couple of members have suggested that we go to the General Assembly and ask them to allocate more taxpayer dollars to our retirement fund. Let me ask you this: why would they do that? We don't work for the taxpayers anymore.

Before I move on, there is another misconception that needs to be clarified. Contrary to what some have said, the Governor and members of the Ohio legislature, as well as the OPERS Board, have exactly the same health care plan as the rest of us. These changes affect them as well as us.

Legislative Report by John Gilchrist



A new session of the Ohio General Assembly, the 130th, began this January. All bills that did not pass as of December

31, 2012 are dead and must be re-introduced and assigned a new bill number. As of this writing, no bills on any subject have been introduced in the Ohio General Assembly; however, we anticipate that a number of retirement proposals will be addressed during this session.

Part of the legislature's explanation for their two year delay on passing the pension legislation was that they wanted to get it right so they would not have to address it again for many years into the future. Interestingly, while hearings were ongoing, we heard that the five pension bills were just the beginning and that additional issues would be addressed in this General Assembly.

Issues that could be on the table include converting the five systems from defined benefit plans to defined contribution plans, the

adequacy of the current contribution rates, double-dipping, disability issues, pension pick-up, and other issues that would only affect one retirement system.

The issue with which we are most concerned is the desire of many legislators to change the funds from defined benefit plans to defined contribution plans. This, in our opinion, would result in the end of the five retirement systems as we know them.

PERI has consistently favored the defined benefit plan over the defined contribution plan and has consistently opposed any attempts at conversion. As you know, under a defined contribution plan the retiree's benefit is based upon what has actually been contributed to the participant's individual account, plus the earnings and appreciation on that individual account. Should the systems ever be required to convert to a defined contribution plan, we believe the primary entities that would benefit from such a conversion are financial and investment companies that

OPERS & PERI...what is the difference?

OPERS is the acronym for Ohio Public Employee Retirement System
&

PERI is the acronym for Public Employee Retirees, Inc.

What is the difference?

OPERS is the state agency that administers our pension funds and health care benefits. OPERS sends us our check each month.

PERI is the retiree political action association for all those who receive OPERS checks. PERI keeps on top of all political activity that affects our pension and health care benefits.

PERI was established in 1948 for the exclusive purpose of watching legislation pertaining to, and the management of, our pension system.

would be managing and maintaining these individual accounts—there are over 705,000 active, contributing members in the five systems; OPERS alone has over 365,000 active contributing members. These financial entities would benefit from the various fees that will be extracted from each member's account.

Approximately 72% of an individual's retirement benefit from OPERS comes from the retirement fund's investment returns. It is interesting to note that it only takes a few years in retirement before a retiree has received in benefits all that has been paid in by the retiree himself and his employer—the rest of his pension and benefits are paid from the investment returns of the system.

Under a defined contribution plan, members would have to invest well if they are going to have a livable life style in retirement. Members would have to base their investment decisions upon the advice of an account manager who may be more interested in selling investment products, than enriching clients.

Under the current defined benefit plan, the retirement system has the responsibility and capability to hire in-house investment experts and outside consultant firms to advise them in their investment decisions and how to properly establish appropriate asset allocations.

If we were under a defined contribution plan these past few years, retiree pension spendable income would have declined between 20 and 50%. On the other hand, OPERS, for example, saw its assets decline by 26.9% and there were no cuts in our pensions or discussions about having the legislature bail us out. Unlike a pension system, individuals living on their own investment portfolio generally cannot afford to ride out a financial downturn.

Another issue that will probably be addressed in this new General Assembly is the issue of double-dipping. Although double-dipping has a negligible, if any, financial

impact on the system, there has been a great deal of negative press on this issue of late and the public has a negative perception of those who double-dip. There were several bills in the past General Assembly that addressed the double-dipping issue.

Under one, the retirement benefit of a retiree who returns to public employment would be suspended with the benefit being placed in an account maintained by the system. Another bill proposed to limit the retirement benefits for re-employed retirees. Under the limitation provision, a retiree earning in excess of \$14,160 would forfeit one dollar of retirement benefits for each two dollars of earnable salary. It is doubtful that any legislative change dealing with double-dipping would affect current retirees.

The pension bill that recently passed, S. B. No. 343, made changes to the disability program; however, these changes did not affect those in the Law Enforcement division. This new law adopts an "any occupation" standard under which eligibility for a disability benefit ultimately ceases if the recipient is capable of performing a job that meets certain requirements. Prior to this law change, eligibility for a disability benefit ceased if the recipient was able to perform the recipient's former job—an "own occupation" standard. We may see a proposal that would attempt to enact some version of the "any occupation" standard for those in the Law Enforcement division, also.

Lastly, we could see a proposal that would limit the use of pension pick-ups for public employees. Under a pension pick-up arrangement, the public employer offers to pay a certain percentage of the employee's pension contribution. Proponents of pension pick-ups contend that pension pick-ups have been used by public employers to save taxpayer money. They contend that a 2% pension pick-up, for example, costs less than a 2% wage increase because of the "roll up" costs of a wage increase. Roll ups include such expenses as increases in employer's pension costs, BWC rates, and State and Federal taxes.

When the OPERS board addressed the health care funding problem, they first established a set of guiding principles. The primary one was that benefits should be for the contributors (workers). Each contributor should get the same benefit allotment. Allotments should be based on years of service, and workers should be the same age when their benefits first become available.

For example, a single worker earning \$20 per hour, and a married worker with two children earning \$20 per hour, both contribute the same amount into the pension system. Consequently each worker should receive the same dollar benefit, thus eliminating the current practice of the single worker receiving a smaller benefit, because he, or she, has been subsidizing the family members of the other worker. The worker who has 10 years of service will no longer receive the same health care benefit as the member with 30 years of service. Each person will receive a benefit allotment based on the number of years they have worked.

Before we leave this topic, I want to thank our members for all that you did to help us represent retirees in the most forceful and professional manner possible. When changes to employer and employee contribution levels were introduced in the 2011-2012 budget, we waged an all-out campaign to educate legislators on how that would effectively eliminate all health care coverage.

During the two years of health care restructuring meetings at OPERS, PERI representatives were there to make sure that the interests of current retirees were not overlooked and remained in proper balance with those of current and future workers.

Moving forward, we realize that the first emotion one experiences when confronted with a major change is fear, then anger, then a desire to strike back.

Most of us have been through all of these phases, and are now ready to move on.

WHY DO WE HAVE DISTRICTS?

To provide for area representation.

It was anticipated that at certain times issues would arise in one geographic area that may impact us all.

Those who set up our PERI Constitution realized that our members would be better informed, if they could work together in close-knit groups.

Each of the 11 Ohio Districts elects its own representative. This representative becomes a member of the PERI State Board of Trustees.

He or she brings to the Board’s attention those issues that arise in the district. In addition, he or she keeps the members of the district up to date on legislative action being taken by PERI.

Once a year, each District holds a District Annual Meeting for all PERI members in its geographic area. The District Representative sets the time and place, and coordinates the meeting. Each of the chapters contributes finances and workers to conduct the event.

DISTRICT REPRESENTATIVES

Information about the position of District Representative is primarily found in article IX of the PERI constitution.

When does your District elect its Representative?

Odd numbered Districts (1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11) hold their elections during the odd numbered years. Even number Districts (2, 4, 6, 8, 10) hold their elections during the even number years.

How are candidates picked?

Each chapter has a member on a Nominating Committee. The committee picks its chairperson, and then receives and/or recruits nominations for the position.

When and where are elections held?

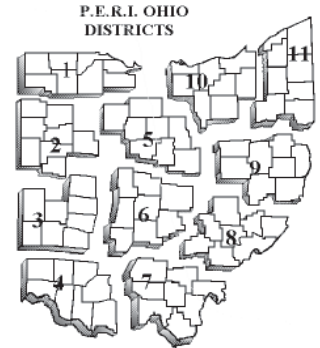
Elections are held during a District’s Annual Meeting. The Chairperson of the Nominating Committee conducts the election by announcing the committee’s nominee(s) and then calling for nominations from the floor. When there is more than one candidate, the election shall be by ballot; otherwise it may be by voice, hand, or ballot vote.

How long is a Representative’s term and how many consecutive terms may they serve?

Each term is two (2) years and they may serve three (3) consecutive terms or six (6) years.

When does a Representative’s term begin and end?

Their term begins at the close of the state (not District) Annual Meeting, and ends at the close of the state Annual Meeting during the second year of their term.



What would happen if a Representative resigns, dies, or no one is elected?

The PERI Board of Directors may leave the office vacant until the District’s next scheduled election, or they may appoint a Representative, or call a special election.

DISTRICTS HELP SELECT CANDIDATES

Districts help select candidates for the State Officer positions by serving as members on the Nominating Committee at the state PERI office.

During the odd numbered years, a person from each odd numbered District is selected to serve; and during the even numbered years, a person from each even numbered District is selected to serve.

(These committee members are selected by the majority vote of the Chapter Presidents in the District.)

Because of these procedures, Districts maintain significant input in the overall operation of our association.

Last fall OPERS announced changes to the retiree health care plan and mailed Comprehensive Guides to Pension and Health Care Changes to all active members and retirees. In the weeks since the guides were made available, we've received a number of phone calls and e-mails from retirees with questions concerning how and when the changes will be implemented and also seeking more information about the OPERS Medicare Connector.

To help you better understand how we plan to make the transition from today's health care plan to the new plan, we have outlined the changes by year (2013 – 2020) below. Most participants will see a reduction in their allowance amount as the transition is made from their "current" allowance percentage to their "new" allowance percentage beginning in 2015. For more information on monthly allowances, please see the Comprehensive Guide to Pension and Health Care Changes for Retired Members.

Currently, we have limited details available pertaining to the OPERS Medicare Connector. We do know that retirees choosing to participate will have access to a licensed Medicare advisor who will help the retiree (and their spouse, if applicable) sort through different plan options and select an individual Medicare plan that best suits his or her health needs and financial circumstances. Please remember we have two years before the OPERS Medicare Connector will be up and running. We would greatly appreciate your patience as we work out the details of this new type of coverage. As soon as additional information is available, we will publish it within your OPERS newsletter and also on our website.

2013:

- Plan design changes as outlined in your open enrollment materials

2014:

- Plan design changes as outlined in 2014 open enrollment materials

Retiree:

- Retiree allowance percentage will stay the same as in 2013
- Retiree Medicare Part B reimbursement will be a maximum of \$96.40

Spouse:

- Spouse allowance percentage will stay the same as in 2013

Children:

- Child allowance percentage will stay the same as in 2013

2015:

Retiree:

- OPERS will no longer sponsor a medical or prescription drug plan for retirees eligible for Medicare Parts A and B. These retirees will have the option to select an individual Medicare plan through the OPERS Medicare Connector. Retirees eligible for both Medicare Parts A and B (and their eligible spouse, if applicable) will receive a monthly health care allowance within a Health Reimbursement Account (HRA). The retiree can use the funds within the HRA to be reimbursed for their qualified health care expenses (including monthly premiums, co-pays, deductibles, etc.)
- OPERS will continue to sponsor a plan for retirees not yet eligible for Medicare and retirees not

- eligible for Medicare Part A
- Retiree allowance will be reduced by one-third of the difference between the "current" (2014) allowance amount and the "new" allowance amount (See page 5 of the Comprehensive Guide to Pension and Health care Changes for Retired Members)
- Retiree Medicare Part B reimbursement will be reduced to no more than \$64.60

Spouse:

- Spouse allowance will be reduced by one-third (from "current" (2014) amount toward a \$0 allowance in 2017)

Children:

- Child allowance will be reduced by one-third (from "current" (2014) amount toward a \$0 allowance in 2017) for children of retirees with less than 20 years of service; toward 50% of retiree's allowance in 2017 for children of retirees with 20 or more years of service)

2016:

Retiree:

- Retiree allowance will be reduced by two-thirds of the difference between the "current" (2014) allowance amount and the "new" allowance amount (See page 5 of the Comprehensive Guide to Pension and Health care Changes for Retired Members)
- Retiree Medicare Part B reimbursement will be reduced to no more than \$31.80

Spouse:

- Spouse allowance will be reduced by two-thirds (from "current" (2014) amount toward a \$0 allowance in 2017)

Children:

- Child allowance will be reduced by two-thirds (from "current" (2014) amount toward a \$0 allowance in 2017) for children of retirees with less than 20 years of service; toward 50% of retiree's allowance in 2017 for children of retirees with 20 or more years of service)
- Plan design changes as needed for Non-Medicare participants

2017:

Retiree:

- Retiree allowance will be at the "new" allowance amount reflecting age and years of service at retirement
- Retiree Medicare Part B reimbursement will be eliminated (\$0)

Spouse:

- Spouse allowance will be eliminated. Spouses can still participate in the OPERS plan, but at the full monthly cost.

Children:

- Child allowance will be eliminated for children of retirees with less than 20 years of service. These children can still participate in the OPERS plan, but at the full monthly cost.
- Child allowance will be reduced to 50% of retiree's allowance in 2017 for children of retirees with 20 or more years of service.

2018 and 2019:

- Same as 2017

2020:

- Spouses will no longer be allowed access to the OPERS health care plan at their own cost. OPERS will likely revisit this topic in 2019 prior to making a final decision on discontinuing access to the plan for spouses.
