### Legislative Report

Anticipating that the upcoming Governmental Accounting Standard Board's (GASB) accounting standards (GASB Standards 67 & 68) may generate misunderstandings and negative reactions, H.C.R. 40 has been introduced. The Resolution pledges the General Assembly's continued support of Ohio's public employers and the five retirement systems and supports their efforts to comply with the standards. It also urges public employers to avail themselves of every opportunity to educate their officers fully in order to comply with the new GASB standards and to encourage the public to understand the difference between accounting and funding standards.

According to the Ohio Retirement Study Council's analysis, the two new standards change the accounting and financial reporting requirements (methods) for the retirement systems and public employers.

### INSIGHT FROM THE ADMINISTRATOR

As early as 1999 it began to be apparent that our retirement system was going to be unable to maintain the same level of health care coverage that had evolved since it was first instituted in 1973.

PERI and ORTA, the Ohio Retired Teachers Association, worked with their respective retirement systems and the Ohio General Assembly to secure the passage of amended H.B. 430, the bill which first allowed retirement systems to provide a health care benefit. The original plan was a split insurance premium arrangement, where the retiree paid half and the retirement system paid half.

In 1974 the retirement system switched from Blue Cross to Aetna and began paying the whole cost of the plan. From there benefits and persons covered increased with no premiums, until the number of people covered and the accelerating cost of health care

overwhelmed the retirement system's capacity to fund the program.

At the end of 1999 the retirement system began working on a plan to save the health care fund. The plan was called the health care preservation plan, generally referred to as HCPP 1.0. PERI, along with other stakeholder groups, was involved with the discovery and discussions that eventually resulted in the first "measured" pull back: minor adjustments and small increases to member costs.

Over the next ten years the retirement system enacted subsequent versions of the plan without stakeholder participation. Because stakeholders were not involved in these discussions, these subsequent revisions resulted in some unwise, in our opinion, and very unpopular decisions.

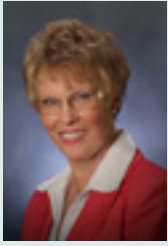
By the late 2000s, it was obvious to the retirement system and its stakeholders that it was

## A Message From the Chairman



Now that the hustle and bustle of the holidays are over and we are at the beginning

of a new year, it is good to take the time to reflect on all the good things that have occurred.

At PERI, we are thankful for many blessings in the past year. One big one is that we still have our health care program, and over the next two years there will be no major changes.

A great deal of the salvation of the OPERS health care benefit came about by the legislative efforts of the OPERS and PERI government relation teams in urging the legislature to take immediate action on SB 343. These efforts were backed up by members of our chapter legislative networks personally contacting their local legislators. If we had not been prepared, we may have lost our health care benefit entirely.

Switching to another topic, do you know that many private and public pension programs have been changed from defined benefit (like we have) to defined contribution (401K or similar investment products)? Statistics in those states that have changed programs have shown that administrative costs are more and that pensions are smaller

under the defined contribution model.

Being prepared to repel any efforts to change our retirement plan design is a really good reason to get involved with your PERI chapter's legislative network. By doing so, you can help to protect our pensions and benefits.

Even if you are not a part of a local chapter, you may still participate in our Email legislative network. All you have to do is send us your Email address and be willing to contact your legislators. We will send you legislative alerts when necessary.

In closing, I would like to remind you that legislative insight is a two way street. When you hear on TV, or read in your local newspaper, some pension topic you feel uncertain about, send us an email or call your district representative. That way we will be knowledgeable of everything that is going on.

On the state level, our legislative council, Mr. Gilchrist, constantly keeps the board up to date on any pending or current legislation, and our administrator, Mr. Winegarner, does the same with activities at the retirement system.

Working together, we will prevail.

going to require more than minor adjustments to keep the health care fund from running out of money before 2020: no more health care benefit for current or future retirees. To save the benefit, two major actions were going to be required. The first was the passage of legislation to make major changes to the pension plan, and the second was for the OPERS Board to make major changes to the health care benefit structure.

The retirement system rose to the occasion by taking action on both fronts: the Alternate Plan Design [pension] and the Health Care Preservation Plan 3.0. The task before the Health Care Committee was to analyze and restructure the entire health care benefit. Prevailing opinion is that without PERI's involvement, the retirement system would still be waiting for the legislature to act on an alternate plan design; however, when it came to the health care meetings, PERI and the other stakeholders groups were notified of the meetings, but not included as full participants, as they had been in the original HCPP 1.0 meetings. Our input came from what I refer to as "working the room." Simply put, we listened to the discussions and then talked with the retirement system staff and board members during the breaks, encouraging them to consider and or present the viewpoints of our membership. I do think it is important for you to know that before the final decisions were made, I was honored to address the committee on be-

half of retirees, and to remind them of our participation in helping maintain OPERS as one of the best public retirement systems in the country.

Getting back to the health care dilemma, the committee began with a clean slate. No one was eligible for benefits, no one was grandfathered, and no benefit that had been pre-slated to remain. In other words, they began from the beginning. Who should be eligible, what should the benefit accomplish, and what level of sustainable funding could be reasonably guaranteed.

Actuaries, consultants, insurance experts, and a myriad of others advisors labored over a two year period to develop the final HCPP 3.0 plan. From my perspective, no stone was left unturned. Even up to today, I have yet to hear of any new angle of consideration that was not fully explored during those health care committee meetings.

Do I think retiree interests were given their just consideration? In my opinion, our retiree representatives on the board did an admirable job, especially John Maurer who suffered the disdain of his fellow board members on many occasions, when he took a steadfast position for retirees. Did we get everything we wanted? No. Were our contributions to preserve and protect the retirement system over the past 60 years given full weight in determining benefit share? Yes. Do I agree with every decision that was made,

Standard 67, titled: “Financial Reporting for Pension Plans,” revises existing guidance for the financial reports of public pension plans. Standard 68, titled: “Accounting and Financial Reporting for Pensions,” revises existing guidance for the financial reports of state and local governments providing pension benefits. Standard 67 takes effect in 2014 and Standard 68 in 2015.

As the Ohio Public Employees Retirement System (OPERS) explains it, public employers’ net pension liability (unfunded liability) will be calculated under the new standards and then allocated to all participating employers. In short, this means that OPERS-covered employers will be responsible for reporting a portion OPERS’s unfunded liability on their financial statements.

OPERS stresses that these new accounting standards dictate the manner in which the net pension liability is accounted for and NOT how it is funded. The funding requirement will not change; OPERS-participating employers will continue to be responsible for funding the statutory contribution requirements; however, employers will now have the added responsibility of reporting a portion of the OPERS’ net pension liability on their financial statement.

In adopting these standards, GASB has stated, “It is important to note that the new statements relate to accounting and financial reporting issues only—how pension costs and obligations are measured and reported in audited external financial reports. The statements do not address how governments approach pension funding.”

By way of background, the Government Accounting Standards Board (GASB) is an organization that sets guidelines for accounting and financial reporting. GASB is not a government entity; it is an independent non-profit organization

that is recognized as the official issuer of generally accepted accounting principles (GAAP) that guide state and local governments.

Since these changes are substantial and can be easily misunderstood, H.C.R 40 serves as a notification of the changes. PERI fully supports H. C. R. 40; it passed the House on a 90-0 vote and awaits Senate action.

PERI also supports another House Concurrent Resolution. H.C.R. 19 memorializes Congress to oppose any legislation that requires social security coverage for members of any of Ohio’s state retirement systems. It should be noted that concurrent resolution’s prime sponsor, Rep. Kirk Schuring, has stated that the introduction of this resolution was not prompted by any specific action going on in Congress. He stated, “There is no bill currently pending before Congress and that the resolution takes a preemptive position in asking Congress to take no action that would jeopardize Ohio’s retirement systems.” The resolution has passed.

Recently we testified in opposition to a bill (H. B. No 162) that would add extortion, perjury, and certain federal offenses to the offenses committed by a public retirement system member while serving in a position of honor, trust, or profit that may result in forfeiture of the retirement system benefit or the termination of retirement system disability benefits. Those who serve in a position of honor, trust, or profit include elected officials, certain individuals serving on boards or commissions, key state and local policy-making officials, prosecutors, peace officers, and highway patrol troopers.

We oppose the bill because it would use the forfeiture of retirement benefits as an additional punishment for the commission of the enumerated offenses. PERI believes that the money in the retirement systems is not public money and as such should not be used for purposes unrelated to retirement and disability benefits. It is true that public employees were paid for

their services with tax dollars, but once the public employee earned the salary and a portion of it was deposited into the retirement system, that money lost its characterization as public money and became private funds held in trust for that employee. PERI believes there are some parallels here with the JobsOhio issue. As we understand it, JobsOhio is a quasi-public entity much like the retirement systems. JobsOhio receives some \$100 million in taxpayer money in the form of liquor profits. The legislature has determined that this public money loses its characterization as public money when received by JobsOhio. In addition, the legislature has proclaimed that these moneys are not subject to audit by the Auditor of State.

In closing, I want to mention one more bill (H. B. No. 285) that we are following. It deals with what the News Media refers to as double-dipping and provides that an individual retiring after the effective date of the bill and who is re-employed as a public employee will not receive the pension portion of the retirement allowance for the period of employment. Up to now there has been little formal legislative activity on the bill.

The following are some of the headlines that have appeared over the past three months:



- Arizona: Goldwater co-founder launches drive to curb size of public-employee pensions.
- California: Pension fight is on.
- Colorado: Board looks to avoid jeopardizing public employee pensions.
- Florida: Recommend an increase in employee contributions and adjustments to COLAs.
- Georgia: Two years after pension reform, Atlanta unions file suit.
- Illinois: Public pension targeted in new bill.
- Kentucky: Think tank says Kentucky's pension liabilities now more than \$70 billion.
- Maryland: Baltimore Mayor proposed switch from a traditional defined benefit pension system to a 401(k)-style plan.
- Minnesota: Commission to decide if a defined benefit pension plan to a 401(k)-like plan was feasible.
- New Mexico: Court hears case over educator pension cuts.
- Oklahoma: Pushing the state legislature for drastic changes to the public pension system.
- Oregon: Governor signed law that reduces COLA increases for most retired public employees.
- Pennsylvania: Bill proposed to switch all new state and public school employees to defined contribution plans.
- Rhode Island: Senator asks SEC to probe state pension fund.
- Tennessee: Pension task force holds first meeting.

**The political-pension world in which we live is best summarized in the first sentence of an article titled DEADBEAT GOVERNMENTS, by James Surowiecki, which was published in The New Yorker magazine on the December 23, 2013. The sentence is as follows:**

***“Tis the season for taking retirement benefits away from public Workers.”***

A retiree's best line of defense, in protecting their own pension, is knowledge. One needs to know what is going on in order to protect their pension and benefits.

## **OPERS Medicare Connector Update**

When the OPERS Medicare Connector becomes effective Jan. 1, 2016, OPERS will no longer sponsor a group Medicare Advantage plan or a Medicare D prescription plan. Instead, Medicare A/B-eligible retirees will receive an allowance through the Connector to purchase an individual Medicare Advantage or Medicare Supplement plan and a Medicare D prescription plan.

There are many very affordable plans available on the individual marketplace. While it may sound counter intuitive, we have found that individual Medicare plans are more affordable than group Medicare plans—like the one currently offered by OPERS. With the change in allowance levels and elimination of Medicare Part B reimbursement, we wanted to offer an array of affordable, high quality plan choices. The best place to find these types of plans is within the individual Medicare marketplace.

## **Why a Connector?**

The OPERS Medicare Connector will allow Medicare A/B-eligible retirees more plan choices than ever before. Not everyone has the same needs when it comes to health care coverage and what's affordable for one retiree, may be too expensive for another. With the Connector, retirees choosing to participate will be able to select a plan that suits their individual needs and budget. Also, Connector participants won't be on their own to find the perfect plan, Licensed Benefit Advisors will be there to help every step of the way. More than 40 million Americans are enrolled in individual Medicare plans and most report a high level of satisfaction with their plan.

Based on extensive research of the individual Medicare marketplace and the Medicare Connector model, we feel confident that OPERS retirees will find a plan that fully satisfies their individual needs via the

OPERS Medicare Connector. In addition, we anticipate that the allowance provided to Connector participants should largely cover the cost of their plan. Many will even have allowance dollars remaining to pay Medicare Part B premiums, use toward the purchase of a plan for their spouse or pay co-pays for office visits or prescriptions.

## **When will we know more about the OPERS Medicare Connector?**

OPERS is currently involved in an extensive procurement process to locate and secure a contract with an organization to provide Medicare Connector services. We anticipate being able to provide additional details later this year.

## **When will I know how much I will have to spend?**

Retirees enrolled in Medicare Parts A and B and eligible for an allowance will receive more information about their allowance amount by the end of 2014.

## **What can a retiree do now to prepare for the Medicare Connector?**

Retirees do not need to do anything right now but if you want to learn more, you can educate yourself about Medicare and Medicare plans. Become familiar with plans available in your area, what the plans cover and what they cost. There are countless resources available to help you do this, including:

2. Visit [www.insurance.ohio.gov](http://www.insurance.ohio.gov) (1-800-686-1526) – By clicking on the “Medicare Services” tab, you can find a wealth of Medicare information specific to Ohioans.

3. **Talk to your family, friends and neighbors** – Chances are most of your peers have experience choosing a plan on the individual Medicare market. Talk with them about what plan they chose and why it works for them.
